The Medicare allied health initiative allows chronically ill people (including those with cancer) who are being managed by their General Practitioner (GP) with a GP management plan and Team Care Arrangements, access to Medicare rebates for allied health services.

You are entitled to 5 visits per year. These can be used with one or many types of the following allied health services

Aboriginal health worker • audiologist • chiropractor • diabetes educator • dietician exercise physiologist • mental health worker • occupational therapist • osteopath physiotherapist • podiatrist • psychologist • speech pathologist.

Your GP can refer you to this program and only registered allied health professionals working in private practice can provide services through this scheme.

If you need treatment from 2 or more health professionals, your doctor may also put a Team Care Arrangement plan in place for you. This lets your doctor work with, and refer you to, at least 2 other health professionals who will provide treatment or services to you.
